# Meditations For Your Week

Sunday, August 23 ~ Saturday, August 29



**Sunday:** *“Out of the depths I cry to you, O Lord.” Psalm 130:1.* Challenges surround us. Call out to God who is faithful.

**Monday:** *“Lord, hear my voice! Let your ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications!” Psalm 130:2.* Over generations, God’s people have called on God. Join your ancestors in the faith in calling out to God.

**Tuesday:** *“My soul waits for the Lord more than those who watch for the morning, more than those who watch for the morning.” Psalm 130:6.* Consider finding a quiet moment to wait for the Lord.

**Wednesday:** *“O Israel, hope in the Lord! For with the Lord there is steadfast love, and with him is great power to redeem.” Psalm 130:7.* Hope is a light in the darkness and a way forward. Hope in the Lord!

**Thursday:** *“My God, my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold and my refuge, my savior; you save me from violence.” 2 Samuel 22:3.* Talk a walk. Notice the rocks around you and contemplate God’s steadiness, refuge, and protection.

**Friday:** *“I call upon the Lord, who is worthy to be praised, and I am saved from my enemies.” 2 Samuel 22:4.* Sing out praise to the God. Find a hymn, praise song, or spiritual you can sing or listen to when you are discouraged.

**Saturday:** *“In my distress I called upon the Lord; to my God I called. From his temple he heard my voice, and my cry came to his ears.” 2 Samuel 22:7.* When someone asks you how you have gotten through a challenge, give credit to God.
