After one month of vacation, pupils are now back to school for the new academic year. In our previous publication we mentioned about class seven pupils who wrote their national exams. We are happy to announce that results are out and all have passed. Thanks for those who remembered us in prayers because your prayers were not in vein.

The school has got about 350 pupils, some of them are orphans. Most of these orphans are facing challenges with payment of their fees. In the previous year, the record showed a list of about 10 children who are being sponsored with their fees. Special thanks to all our sponsors and may God continue to bless you in all aspects of your lives.

However, the need is still huge, your contribution will be most welcomed. Help one Tanzanian orphan go back to school with only \$180 per month at Wesley primary school.

Results of a review that we carried this month showed that some pupils have to walk long distances to reach to school everyday. Therefore, in order to improve accessibility to our pupils, currently the school has a project of purchasing a van which will be transporting pupils from home to school and from school to home.

We have got also a project of building a school library which will be conducive and corresponding to the needs of pupils.
