Good Works workday staff, who are also volunteers, organize the work, plan for the needed materials, and accompany each group to the homes needing work. Applicants who have been approved by our agency receive repair services on their homes free of charge. All tools and supplies are provided and our volunteers even teach people how to do what is needed! Workday staff remain in the home the entire time working beside the volunteers; you are never left on your own and there will always be someone to help you if you are unsure how to proceed.
