Old Testament Lesson: 2 Samuel 22:1-7

David spoke to the Lord the words of this song on the day when the Lord delivered him from the hand of all his enemies, and from the hand of Saul. He said:

The Lord is my rock, my fortress, and my deliverer, my God, my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold and my refuge, my savior; you save me from violence.

In my distress I called upon the Lord; to my God I called.

Meditations For Your Week

Sunday, August 23 ~ Saturday, August 29



- **Sunday:** *"Out of the depths I cry to you, O Lord." Psalm 130:1.* Challenges surround us. Call out to God who is faithful.
- **Monday:** "Lord, hear my voice! Let your ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications!" Psalm 130:2. Over generations, God's people have called on God. Join your ancestors in the faith in calling out to God.
- **Tuesday:** "My soul waits for the Lord more than those who watch for the morning, more than those who watch for the morning." Psalm 130:6. Consider finding a quiet moment to wait for the Lord.
- **Wednesday:** "O Israel, hope in the Lord! For with the Lord there is steadfast love, and with him is great power to redeem." Psalm 130:7. Hope is a light in the darkness and a way forward. Hope in the Lord!
- **Thursday:** "My God, my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold and my refuge, my savior; you save me from violence." 2 Samuel 22:3. Talk a walk. Notice the rocks around you and contemplate God's steadiness, refuge, and protection.
- **Friday:** "I call upon the Lord, who is worthy to be praised, and I am saved from my enemies." 2 Samuel 22:4. Sing out praise to the God. Find a hymn, praise song, or spiritual you can sing or listen to when you are discouraged.
- **Saturday:** "In my distress I called upon the Lord; to my God I called. From his temple he heard my voice, and my cry came to his ears." 2 Samuel 22:7. When someone asks you how you have gotten through a challenge, give credit to God.
