

Old Testament Lesson: Deuteronomy 31:5-6

The Lord will give them over to you and you shall deal with them in full accord with the command that I have given to you. Be strong and bold; have no fear or dread of them, because it is the Lord your God who goes with you; he will not fail you or forsake you."

Gospel Lesson: Mark 3:13-19

Jesus went up the mountain and called to him those whom he wanted, and they came to him. And he appointed twelve, whom he also named apostles, to be with him, and to be sent out to proclaim the message, and to have authority to cast out demons. So he appointed the twelve: Simon (to whom he gave the name Peter); James son of Zebedee and John the brother of James (to whom he gave the name Boanerges, that is, Sons of Thunder); and Andrew, and Philip, and Bartholomew, and Matthew, and Thomas, and James son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus, and Simon the Cananaean, and Judas Iscariot, who betrayed him. Then he went home.

MOMENT OF IMPACT Covenant Missionary – Mrs. Ngoy M. Kalangwa

For many years, we have supported covenant missionary, Mrs. Ngoy M. Kalangwa. She is married to The Reverend Llunga Kalangwa. They are both from the Democratic Republic of Congo as United Methodist General Board of Global Missions missionaries commissioned to serve in Tanzania. She works particularly with women on skills and education. She writes the following at Easter: "The women at the Suzannah Wesley Center are in their final stages of their training. Soon in June, there will be a new group of women who will join us and acquire the skills that will empower them in their households. Each person in this training will receive a sewing machine to begin on their own. We thank you for your supports because we were able to receive enough sewing machines for this group. Furthermore, the women leaders of The UMC in Tanzania had come together to discuss and development of our church as well as women's in the society. We discussed about the influence of women in the church today. The Suzannah Wesley Education and Health Center continues to provide healthcare to the community. The clinic has added some new instruments for the laboratory, a new microscope and a centrifuge. These instruments will surely enable our clinic to offer good diagnosis of diseases like Malaria and illnesses; subsequently, provide better treatments to the community."
