### Old Testament Lesson: Psalm 29

Ascribe to the Lord, O heavenly beings, ascribe to the Lord glory and strength. Ascribe to the Lord the glory of his name; worship the Lord in holy splendor. 
### PRAYER BEAD GARDEN PAVERS
