

New Testament Lesson: Romans 10:9-13

Because if you confess with your lips that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For one believes with the heart and so is justified, and one confesses with the mouth and so is saved. The scripture says, "No one who believes in him will be put to shame." For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; the same Lord is Lord of all and is generous to all who call on him. For, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved."

Gospel Lesson: *Matthew* 6:7-9

"When you are praying, do not heap up empty phrases as the Gentiles do; for they think that they will be heard because of their many words. Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him.

Pray then in this way:

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name.

MOMENT OF IMPACT—Lenten Mission Project

During Lent, help us provide UMCOR hygiene kits. Providing basic necessities to people who have been forced to leave their homes because of human conflict or natural disaster. Hygiene kits are also used as learning tools in personal hygiene, literacy, nutrition and cooking classes.

Kits include:

- One hand towel (15 x 25 –17 x 27 inches) No kitchen, cleaning, or microfiber towels
- o One washcloth—No kitchen, cleaning, or microfiber towels
- One comb—Must be sturdy with at least 6 inches of teeth—No pocket combs or picks—Rattail and combs without handles are acceptable but must have at least 6 inches of teeth
- o One toenail or fingernail clipper—No emery boards or metal nail files
- O Bath-size soap (3 oz. bar or larger) No Ivory or Jergen's soap—Do not remove from packaging
- One adult toothbrush—Do not remove from packaging -Personal advertising not acceptable
- o 10 adhesive bandages (¾ by 3 inches), Common household bandages acceptable
- o One one-gallon size re-sealable bag

Elohim, Mighty Creator, who hovered over the waters of the deep and brought order from chaos, we praise your name as you bring order from the chaos of our lives. Yahweh, I AM THAT I AM, who declared to Moses at the bush that burned without being consumed, you have been steadfast, and your love will always remain steadfast throughout time. El Roi, the God who sees us, delivered us from captivity, made covenant to be our sovereign God, El Olam and called us by the prophets to follow.

And so, with your people on earth and all the company of heave we praise your name and join their unending hymn:

Many: Holy, holy, holy, Lord, God of power and might (El Shaddai), Heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is the One who comes in the name of the Lord (Christos). Hosanna in the Highest

One: Holy are you and blessed is your Son, Jesus, anointed Messiah and set apart Christos. Your Spirit anointed him to preach good news to the poor, to proclaim release to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set liberty those who are oppressed, and to announce that the time had come when you would save your people.

The community gathered with Jesus on the night in which Jesus gave himself up for us, Jesus took the bread, gave thanks to you, gave it the disciples, and said: "Take, eat: This is my body which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me.

When the supper was over, in a similar way, Jesus took the cup, gave thanks to you, gave to all present and said: "Drink from this, all of you, this is my blood of the new covenant, poured out for you and for many, for the forgiveness of sins. Do this as often as you drink this, in remembrance of me."

And so, in remembrance of these your mighty acts in Jesus Christ, we offer ourselves in praise and thanksgiving as a holy and living sacrifice, in union with Christ's offering for us as we proclaim the mystery of faith.

Many: Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.

One: Pour out your Holy Spirit on us gathered here and on these gifts of bread and cup, make them be for us the body of Christ made whole through the redemptive work of the Spirit. Let our bodies, temples of the Holy Spirit rediscover the set apart holiness to which God has called us. By your Spirit make us one with Christ, one with each other, and one in ministry with all the world, until Christ comes in final victory, and we feast at Christ's heavenly banquet. Through your Son Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit in your holy Church, all honor and glory is yours, almighty God, now and forever.



Meditations For Your Week

Sunday, March 1 ~ Saturday, March 7, 2020

- **Sunday:** "For one believes with the heart and so is justified, and one confesses with the mouth and so is saved." Romans 10:10. May the abundance of your heart flow through the words of your mouth in praise and confession of your Savior!
- **Monday:** "The scripture says, "No one who believes in him will be put to shame." Romans 10:11. Give thanks to God in prayer for God's faithfulness. God is faithful!

- **Friday:** "Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him." Matthew 6: 8. One of the names of God is YHWH Yireh, God will provide. Where has God provided for you? Where is God calling you to trust that God will provide?
