

New Testament Lesson: 1 Corinthians 3: 5-11

What then is Apollos? What is Paul? Servants through whom you came to believe, as the Lord assigned to each. I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth. So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth. The one who plants and the one who waters have a common purpose, and each will receive wages according to the labor of each. For we are God's servants, working together; you are God's field, God's building. According to the grace of God given to me, like a skilled master builder I laid a foundation, and someone else is building on it. Each builder must choose with care how to build on it. For no one can lay any foundation other than the one that has been laid; that foundation is Jesus Christ.

FOOD PANTRY: Did you know that our food pantry is providing food and primary household products to an average of 50-60 families every week? This increase represents 5-5.5 times the number of bags of groceries than we had provided by this week, last year, and 12 times as many bags as three years ago by this week in 2017. With your generosity and our collaboration with our community partners, we are feeding our neighbors, discovering their need for rental and utility assistance, and disseminating information about public health. We can also store and distribute fresh produce and proteins. As your garden grows, consider sharing with the food pantry. If you have eggs, consider sharing some with your neighbors. Neighbors feeding and caring for neighbors is at the heart of our ministry. Serving God and God's people is our mission. You can drop off your items **Monday, Wednesday, Friday 9- noon** in the shopping cart by the office. Also, if you could use help this season, please come on **Thursdays between 4-6pm** for food.

Meditations For Your Week

Sunday, June 14 ~ Saturday, June 20, 2020

- **Sunday:** "What then is Apollos? What is Paul? Servants through whom you came to believe, as the Lord assigned to each." 1 Corinthians 3: 5. Today is Pastor Monica's last Sunday in worship. We give thanks to God for her and her family and their leadership here at West Grove. We offer them blessings as they prepare to transition to Stroudsburg UMC.
- **Monday:** "I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth." 1 Corinthians 3:6. Consider God may be using your witness as a part of a larger witness. Listen to the movement of the Spirit within you as you feel called to share the stories of God's goodness. You are being called to plant and water. God will give the growth!
- **Tuesday**: "So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth" 1 Corinthians 3: 7. As you spend time in meditation and prayer today, what can you give thanks to God for that God is growing? Is God growing a relationship with a friend or spouse? Is God planting new seeds of discontent for a ministry of advocacy?
- **Wednesday:** "The one who plants and the one who waters have a common purpose, and each will receive wages according to the labor of each." 1 Corinthians 3:8. Consider that God is already at work, even when you can not see it. That which is nagging at you and causing anxiety is already in God's hands. Now, look around for those who are planting and watering hope, faith, and love on behalf of God who will bring the increase and resolution.
- **Thursday:** "For we are God's servants, working together; you are God's field, God's building." 1 Corinthians 3:9. Pray for the global church. All of the world is my parish, John Wesley, the founder of Methodism, said. Together, around the world, we work together for the upbuilding of the kingdom. Pray for the global church.
- **Friday:** "According to the grace of God given to me, like a skilled master builder I laid a foundation, and someone else is building on it. Each builder must choose with care how to build on it. "I Corinthians 3: 10. What are you being called to build in these unusual times? Are you building new habits? Are you whistling hope in the dark? Take care to build upon the foundation of Jesus Christ!
- **Saturday:** "For no one can lay any foundation other than the one that has been laid; that foundation is Jesus Christ." 1 Corinthians 3:11. Praise be to Jesus Christ, the foundation of our faith. You can depend and rest upon him, all you who are weary.
