Scripture Lesson: Mark 1:21-28 (NRSV)

The Man with an Unclean Spirit

They went to Capernaum; and when the sabbath came, he entered the synagogue and taught. They were astounded at his teaching, for he taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes. Just then there was in their synagogue a man with an unclean spirit, and he cried out, "What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are, the Holy One of God." But Jesus rebuked him, saying, "Be silent, and come out of him!" And the unclean spirit, convulsing him and crying with a loud voice, came out of him. They were all amazed, and they kept on asking one another, "What is this? A new teaching—with authority! He commands even the unclean spirits, and they obey him." At once his fame began to spread throughout the surrounding region of Galilee.

Lenten Bible Study Class Mondays, February 22-April 5 6:30 p.m. in the Sanctuary

During the Mondays of Lent, beginning on February 22 and continuing each Monday until the Monday after Easter (April 5th), there will be a Bible Study on the events of each day of Holy Week and for the days following the Resurrection. It will be held in the sanctuary at 6:30 PM and will be supported by a PowerPoint program that I am developing.

This 7-week study will begin with Palm Sunday when Jesus rode triumphantly and victoriously into Jerusalem and will look at the events of each day of Holy Week and will include events leading up to the Ascension of Christ.

Our study will use the Gospel of Mark as our foundational text and add the events from the other Gospels that are not included in Mark.

IN-PERSON WORSHIP IS OPEN! WGUMC is reopening our doors to LIVE worship. Currently, we will offer in-person worship limited to 35 people to allow for safe distancing, as well as continuing to provide our online services. At this time, all music will be recorded. Your health and safety is our primary concern. Masks must be worn at all times, except for presenters. Only the front Narthex doors will be available for entry and a touch-free thermometer will be used to check temperatures. We ask that everyone sanitize their hands using church provided sanitizer before entering the sanctuary. Chairs have been arranged in "pods" to ensure proper social distancing. Some pods will be larger than others to allow people who live together to sit together. There will not be a formal collection: we continue to encourage you to share your tithes and offerings electronically or by mail as we have done since March. At the conclusion of the service please do not congregate in the narthex. Conversations with your fellow attendees can be had safely outside practicing social distancing. We all miss seeing our church family in person. While you may want to reach out and great each other (handshake, hug etc.) please respect the 6 foot social distance guideline.
