The Baptism of Jesus

In those days Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan. And a voice came from heaven, "You are my Son, the Beloved; with you I am well pleased."

Now after John was arrested, Jesus came to Galilee, proclaiming the good news^[b] of God, and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near; repent, and believe in the good news."

LENTEN BIBLE STUDY CLASS Mondays, February 22-April 5 6:30 p.m. in the Sanctuary

During the Mondays of Lent, beginning on February 22 and continuing each Monday until the Monday after Easter (April 5th),there will be a Bible Study on the events of each day of Holy Week and for the days following the Resurrection. It will be held in the sanctuary at 6:30 PM and will be supported by a PowerPoint program that I am developing. This 7-week study will begin with Palm Sunday when Jesus rode triumphantly and victoriously into Jerusalem and will look at the events of each day of Holy Week and will include events leading up to the Ascension of Christ. Our study will use the Gospel of Mark as our foundational text and add the events from the other Gospels that are not included in Mark.
