

Scripture Lesson: Galatians 5:1, 13-26

For freedom Christ has set us free. Stand firm, therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.

For you were called to freedom, brothers and sisters, only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for self-indulgence, but through love become enslaved to one another. For the whole law is summed up in a single commandment, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." If, however, you bite and devour one another, take care that you are not consumed by one another.

The Works of the Flesh

Live by the Spirit, I say, and do not gratify the desires of the flesh. For what the flesh desires is opposed to the Spirit, and what the Spirit desires is opposed to the flesh, for these are opposed to each other, to prevent you from doing what you want. But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not subject to the law. Now the works of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity, debauchery, idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, anger, quarrels, dissensions, factions, envy, drunkenness, carousing, and things like these. I am warning you, as I warned you before: those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

The Fruit of the Spirit

By contrast, the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against such things. And those who belong to Christle have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. If we live by the Spirit, let us also be guided by the Spirit. Let us not become conceited, competing against one another, envying one another.

Offertory Song: "Now Is The Time"

The UMC Eastern Pennsylvania Conference Commission on Religion and Race asked Mel to write a song that reflected the goal the Economic Equity Council arm of that Commission. Rev. Deborah Tanksley-Brown, a spoken word artist, shared the facilitation of this process. The inequalities and inequities that pastors of color experience in relation to remuneration as well as their congregational apportionments need to be addressed "now." The conference's theme of "NOW" was based on the verse from Romans 13:11 – "Now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now, our salvation is nearer than when we first believed."

Keeping that verse and the goals in mind, a gathering of diverse men and women of color, culture, gender, and age contributed specific lines or thoughts that Mel eventually incorporated into the song "Now, Is the Time." Mel's composition was then sent to Rev. Lydia Munoz who converted it to the Latinx version sang at the Annual Conference. The WGUMC Ensemble version will be posted on either the Conference or South District website.
