

Scripture Lesson: Exodus 20:1-7 (NKJV)

And God spoke all these words, saying: 2 "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of [a] bondage. 3 "You shall have no other gods before Me. 4 "You shall not make for yourself a carved image—any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth; 5 you shall not bow down to them nor [b] serve them. For I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, visiting [c] the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third and fourth generations of those who hate Me, 6 but showing mercy to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments. 7 "You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain, for the LORD will not hold him guiltless who takes His name in vain.

The bulk of the food we distribute comes from the Chester County Food Bank. We also receive food from the West Chester Food Cupboard, the Acme in Avondale and the Jennersville and New Garden Giants. We welcome monetary donations and food and household products. The most needed food items include corn tortillas, cooking oil and dry pinto beans. Household and personal items such as detergent, baby wipes, soap,
