

Scripture Lesson: Exodus 33: 12—23 (The Message)

¹²⁻¹³ Moses said to God, "Look, you tell me, 'Lead this people, 'but you don't let me know whom you're going to send with me. You tell me, 'I know you well and you are special to me.' If I am so special to you, let me in on your plans. That way, I will continue being special to you. Don't forget, this is your people, your responsibility." 14 God said, "My presence will go with you. I'll see the journey to the end." ¹⁵⁻¹⁶ Moses said, "If your presence doesn't take the lead here, call this trip off right now. How else will it be known that you're with me in this, with me and your people? Are you traveling with us or not? How else will we know that we're special, I and your people, among all other people on this planet Earth?" 17 God said to Moses: "All right. Just as you say; this also I will do, for I know you well and you are special to me. I know you by name." 18 Moses said, "Please. Let me see your Glory." 19 God said, "I will make my Goodness pass right in front of you; I'll call out the name, God, right before you. I'll treat well whomever I want to treat well and I'll be kind to whomever I want to be kind." 20 God continued, "But you may not see my face. No one can see me and live." ²¹⁻²³ God said, "Look, here is a place right beside me. Put yourself on this rock. When my Glory passes by, I'll put you in the cleft of the rock and cover you with my hand until I've passed by. Then I'll take my hand away and you'll see my back. But you won't see my face."

- ¹ The Lord is king; let the peoples tremble! He sits enthroned upon the cherubim; let the earth quake!
- ² The Lord is great in Zion; he is exalted over all the peoples.
- ³ Let them praise your great and awesome name. Holy is he!
- ⁴ Mighty King, lover of justice, you have established equity; you have executed justice and righteousness in Jacob.
- ⁵ Extol the Lord our God; worship at his footstool. Holy is he!
- ⁶ Moses and Aaron were among his priests, Samuel also was among those who called on his name. They cried to the Lord, and he answered them.
- ⁷ He spoke to them in the pillar of cloud; they kept his decrees and the statutes that he gave them.
- ⁸ O Lord our God, you answered them; you were a forgiving God to them but an avenger of their wrongdoings.

FOOD PANTRY NEWS: The church food pantry provides assistance every week to families in our community dealing with food insecurity. Food is provided by the Chester County Food Bank, Chester Food Cupboard, the Acme in Avondale and the Jennersville and New Garden Giants. We welcome monetary donations, food and household products. The most needed food items include corn tortillas, cooking oil and dry pinto beans. Household and personal items such as detergent, baby wipes, soap, toothpaste, toothbrushes, shampoo and conditioner.
